I, *Charles A. Striebeck*, a naturalized and loyal citizen of the United States, do hereby apply to the *Legation* of the United States at *Berlin* for a passport for myself *and wife* and *my minor children*, as follows: *born* at *_____* on the *_____* day of *_____*, 18*_____*, and

In support of the above application, I do solemnly swear that I was born at *Duisburg* *Prussia*, on or about the *13* day of *April*, 18*46*; that I emigrated to the United States, sailing on board the *Norway* from *Hamburg*, the *_____* day of *August*, 18*72*, and arriving at *New York* the *_____* day of *Sept.* 18*72*; that I resided *four* years uninterruptedly in the United States, from 18*72* to 18*96* at *New York N.Y.*; that I was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the *Common Pleas* Court of *New York City* at *New York N.Y.*, on the *31* day of *October*, 18*94*, as shown by the accompanying certificate of naturalization; that I am the bearer of Passport No. *_____* issued by *_____* on the *_____* day of *_____*, 18*_____*, which is returned herewith; that I am the identical person referred to in said certificate and passport; that I am domiciled in the United States, my permanent residence therein being at *New York*, in the State of *New York*, where I follow the occupation of *merchant*; that I last left the United States on the *30* day of *February*, 18*96*, on board the *Italia*, arriving in *Hamburg* the *14* day of *February*, 18*96*; that I have resided in *Hamburg* since the *11* day of *February*, 18*96*; that I am now temporarily residing at *Hamburg*; and that I intend to return to the United States *within two years* with a purpose of residing and performing the duties of citizenship there. I desire the passport for the purpose of *obtaining permission to reside in Hamburg as an American citizen.*
